- 2. City, Civility and Post-Political. Models of Freedom and Conflict, chaired by Selena Savic (ATTP, TU Wien and IXDM, FHNW Basel)
- 3. Cognitive and sensory strategies for understanding and shaping our environment, from the room to the territory, chaired by Darío Negueruela del Castillo (ALICE, EPFL), Julien Lafontaine Carboni (ALICE, EPFL) and Leonardo Impett (Max-Planck Institut für Kunstgeschichte)
